01 Tokyo Station

東京駅
Designated as a national important cultural property. Designed by Tatsuno Kingo, a renowned architect of the Meiji Period. Completed in 1914 and built in the Renaissance style, it will be restored to its pre-WWII design by 2012.

02 Tokyo Ginko Kyokai Building

東京銀行協会ビル (旧東京銀行本館)
Former brick structure was designed by Kitano Matsui of Yokogawa Komusho and completed in 1916. Two exterior walls have now been restored and a portion of the original interior remains.

03 The Industry Club of Japan

日本工業倶楽部会館
Designed by Kitano Matsui of Yokogawa Komusho with construction completed in 1920. Built in authentic Secession style, a portion of which was preserved when reconstructed in 2004.

04 Tokyo Central Post Office

東京中央郵便局
Designed by Tetsuro Yoshida of the former Ministry of Communications and completed in 1931. The building has served as a post office for the local community for approximately 75 years.

05 Meiji Seimei Kan Building

明治生命館
Designated as the first important cultural property and built in the Showa period. Designed by Shinichiro Okada, construction was completed in 1934. A highly-recognized example of classical architecture.

06 DN Tower 21

DNタワー21 (旧第一生命館)
Formerly the Dai-ichi Seimei Building, the DN Tower 21 was designed by Yosaku Matsumoto and Jin Watanabe and completed in 1938. It is well known for its role in housing the General World Headquarters of the Allied Forces following WWII.

07 The Imperial Palace

皇居
Designated as a special historical landmark by the government. Reflecting the image of the former Edo Castle, the Imperial Palace East Gardens with an original castle keep remain open to the public. Nijubashi Bridge, pictured here, is one of Tokyo's focal points.

08 Gyoko-dori

行幸通り
A road with a width of 73 meters. Before the current road was developed, coaches were used to travel for the ceremony to present letters of credence to newly appointed ambassadors from other countries. It is planned to be completed in 2008 to become the symbol of this district.

09 Masakado's Tomb

将門墓
Designated as a historic landmark by the Tokyo government, this tomb was built to pacify the vengeful spirit of Taira no Masakado (1-940) who was killed in the Revolt of Taira no Masakado. Also called "tsukubaki" meaning a mound where a head is buried.

10 Statue of Kusunoki Masashige

楠木正成銅像
Kusunoki Masashige (1294-1336) was a warrior in the Nanbokucho and early Marunouchi periods. The statue of the samurai was sculpted by Takamura Koon and the base by Goto Seisaku. It is one of the "three largest bronze statues of Tokyo".

11 Statue of Wake no Kiyomaro

和氣清原公親像
Wake no Kiyomaro (713-799) was a court noble in the Heian and early Heian periods. The statue was sculpted by Adachi Chusai.

12 Statue of Ota Dokan

大田道灌銅像
Ota Dokan (1422-1486) was a warrior in the Kamakura region in the late shogunate period. The statue was sculpted by Kawanishi Fumio.

13 Statue of Shibusawa Eichi

渋沢栄一銅像
Shibusawa Eichi (1840-1931) was an entrepreneur in the Meiji and Taisho periods. The statue was sculpted by Adachi Chusai.

14 Mitsubishi Ichigokan Museum, Tokyo

三菱一号館
Mitsubishi Ichigokan, the first office building in Marunouchi, was designed by Josiah Conder and completed in 1894. It will be rebuilt in 2010 and serve as a museum.

15 Tokyo International Forum

東京国際フォーラム
Designed by Rafael Vinoly, it is the first convention and art center in Tokyo, highlighted by the ship-like design of the Glass Hall.

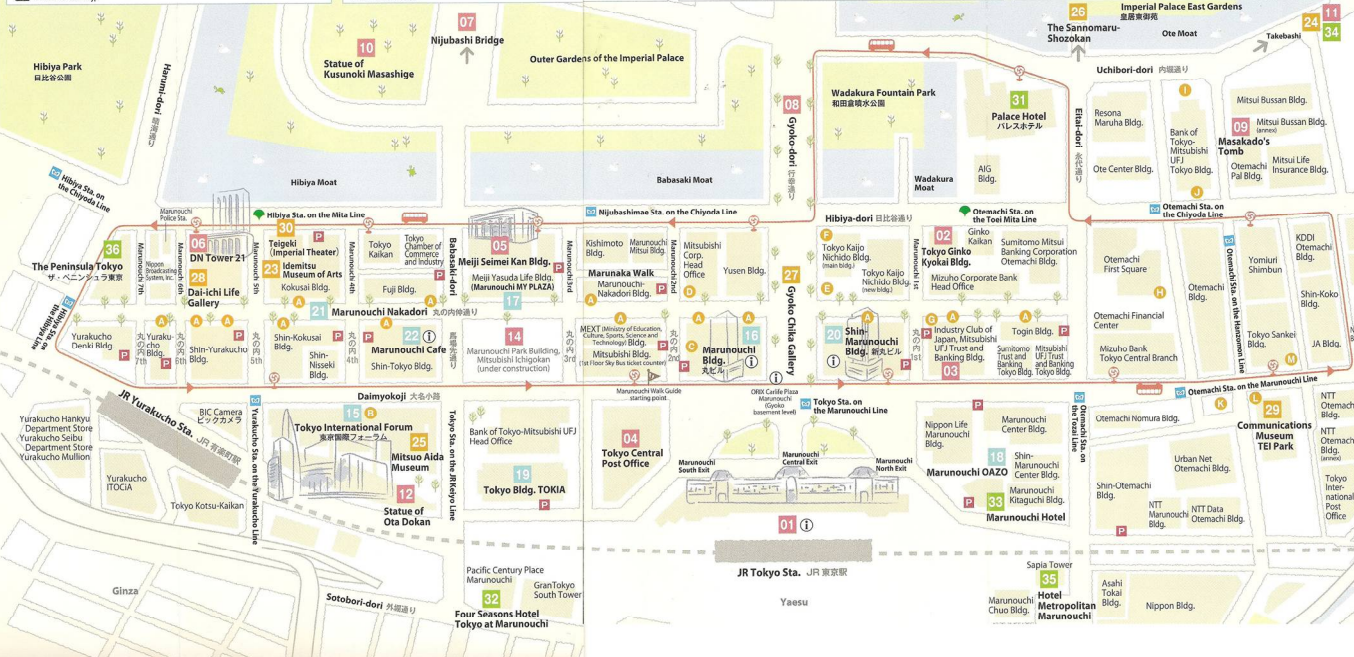

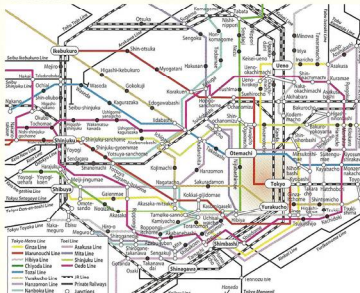
